HEZA WILD GUY broke sharp, set a moderate to slow pace for six furlongs, shook off PLENILUNIO leaving the second turn then drew away when roused. KEYSTONE POINT raced well placed but couldn't threaten the winner while getting up for the place. PLENILUNIO pressed the pace into the stretch then gradually weakened. SINGLE FILE was well placed but had no rally. SIBERIANO failed to menace. INFINITE JUSTICE chased inside to the quarter pole then came up empty. DEACON SPRINGS showed little. PLAY IT OUT was no factor. ON TO RICHMOND stumbled badly at the break unseating his rider. There was a stewards inquiry conducted into the start before the race was declared official.
