WHY WHY WHY AMOUR raced three wide early, settled off the pace, made a four wide run on the far turn, closed willingly and drew clear. WYNNNS AND ROSES duelled outside, took over and dug in gamely to the end. HATTA saved ground, moved up between rivals on the turn and rallied mildly between horses. TUOUBLIERASMONNOM bobbled at the break and was bumped, raced between rivals, angled out at the top of the lane and rallied mildly outside. NEKIA'S VOW settled off the rail, moved up three wide on the far turn and was outkicked. MOHAWK MAGIC was bumped at the start, raced off the pace, made a middle move on the rail, was steadied entering the far turn and failed to threaten. ROAR OF THE KITTY did not factor. CASUALLY PUT raced inside and faded. NIKKI'S CHOICE duelled inside and faded.
