IOYA TWO was slightly rank and green early, settled down to press the pace for six furlongs then drew off smartly through the stretch under a confident hand ride. PEPPERCORN, void of early speed, advanced inside through the second turn, split rivals in mid stretch and was up for the place. THE FUTURE GIRL made a middle move, lugged in after turning for home and lacked a further response. IZUIZORIZUAIN'T dueled for six furlongs and gave way. BAYNETTEBABE, well placed, came up empty. CIGARETTE pressed the pace to the second turn and faded. BLUSHING BRIBE went evenly. NIAS GIRL failed to menace. MOUNTAIN MADAM stopped. (The portable inner rail was set out 22 feet.)
