SECRET STATUS broke sharply, set the pace along the inside to the three-eighths pole, well rated when passed on the far turn, reclaimed the lead at the top of the stretch and prevailed in a game stretch drive. MARCH MAGIC was allowed to settle behind the early leaders, was in tight quarters for a half, angled out for the stretch drive and was outfinished in a game effort. MUSICAL brushed the gate in an awkward start, always raced close up, advanced four wide on the far turn, exchanged bumps dueling with the winner, weakened in late stretch. MY SPECIAL K'S showed little early speed, commenced a bid while five wide on the second turn, failed to sustain the effort and gave way in the stretch. I'M JUST A PEACH was allowed to settle behind the pace, rushed to the forefront along the rail approaching the far turn, led briefly to the quarter pole and tired. GREY SKY showed no speed and was never close. SEE U AT MY WINDOW trailed for a mile and was never in contention. SUMMER MEADOW broke sharply, dueled with the winner for a half and tired.
