INTERNATIONAL CITY made a middle move three wide then ran down the leader in the final strides. SPECIAL INSIGNIA rushed to the lead early, drew off to a long advantage after a half then just failed to last. MISS FIXED INCOME made a middle move to be a threat a furlong out but was outfinished late. TUNETTE was shuffled back to last on the turn then split rivals and closed a gap but too late. CHRISTINA'S HOPE was forwardly placed but failed to gain. LA JOCONDE failed to menace. SATINE ROUGE chased inside for six furlongs then faded. MOONLIGHT SONATA was through after a half. MISS PTARMIGAN chased to the quarter pole then stopped. FIRM REALITY stumbled at the break and lost her rider. There was a stewards inquiry into the incident at the start before the race was declared official. The portable inner rail was set at 12 feet.
