R LADY JOY chased the leader for six furlongs while reserved, challenged outside the leader leaving the second turn to secure a clear lead then drew off steadily while ridden out. TOLL TAKER was hung four wide much of the way, rallied out of the second turn and outfinished the rest while no match for the winner. GOTTA RUSH raced boxed inside in hand for six furlongs then lodged a mild rally once clear. LEONA'S KNIGHT set a slow pace for six furlongs then weakened. LITTLE LUCIFER made a four wide middle move then came up empty. K. D.'S SHADY LADY raced behind the first flight for six furlongs but had no rally. ATLAS VALLEY showed little. EVEN AGAIN showed no speed and failed to threaten. EASTERN LILY chased to the quarter pole then stopped.
