D' WILDCARD made a middle move, angled out five wide then rallied past the leaders through the furlong grounds to be along in time. PRINCE DAVID was hung wide chasing the leaders early, bid five wide3 through the second turn and into the stretch to gain a short lead but couldn't handle the winner late while coming back late for the place. ROCKSIDE ROAD raced close up early, bid in the second turn then dueled to mid stretch before weakening. LION BY MY SIDE set or pressed the pace to mid stretch then gave way. CLAXTON passed tiring rivals. STRATEGIC AIM vied into the stretch then faded. ROBBIE'S EXPRESS was no factor. BAYSTREET BULLY failed to menace. ESPRESSO DOBLE rushed up on the backstretch then stopped.
