EXPECTED TEMPER chased the early leader, bid out of the turn, gained a short lead inside the final furlong then just failed to last. RED HOT SWORD raced close up early, dropped back through the turn then came back on again inside through the late stages. GINGER SPIN fanned six wide then lodged a mild rally late. THERES TROUBLE chased the leaders, was in striking distance a furlong out but failed to respond. EMILY'S REPRIZED raced evenly inside. MYSTICAL ALLURE set the pace to mid stretch then faltered. EASILY RECOGNIZED showed little. MISS AREA CODE failed to menace.
