SINGAPORE CHARLEY chased the winner from the outset, bid after five furlongs then narrowly prevailed after a long drive. SILVER TRINKET broke sharp, set a slow pace under patient handling then resisted the winner gamely to late before hanging while best of the rest. SO WONDERFUL showed improved stamina making a middle move to be in striking distance out of the second turn but failed to gain late. ADVANTAGE PLUS was well placed but had no rally. LITE MEDLEY was also well placed but gave way after six furlongs. ACROSS THE CREEK weakened gradually. YUKAN B A LADY TOO failed to menace. BELLE RIVIERE was through after a half. STARRY MARK made an outside middle move then stopped. The portable rail was set at zero feet.
