THATSTHE FACT JACK was never far back, bid four wide into the stretch then also continued well to late before hanging. VICTORY AT MIDWAY was hung wide into the stretch then weakneed. EVERBLAZING passed tiring rivals. WONDERFIN pressed the pace into the stretch then faded. RUNNIN TO THE BAR was no factor. SPEED STREET showed little. DANCES showed little. E. T. GO HOME stopped.
