SUNNY PLACE set a solid pace, resisted when challenged past mid stretch then weakened. FUNI ACT made a middle move then was going well late. ART OF ATTACK raced evenly. STEAL A STAR pressed the pace for six furlongs then gave way. TEE EM ARR stalked the pace to the quarter pole then came up empty. TIME TIX AHEAD showed little. LORD FOX was no factor.
