WYATT'S WOMEN stalked the pace early, bid three wide after five furlongs to gain the lead then had enough left to turn back a late challenge from G'S BACKINACTION. G'S BACKINACTION made a three wide middle move to contention then finished willingly outside and was getting to the winner late. LYNDSEA'S MISS EL swung outside into the stretch but had only a mild response. ROYALLY SWEET stalked the pace early, bid leaving the second turn then flattened out. L P'S TIGER dueled for five furlongs then gave way. PROUD AND PRETTY was hard used disputing the pace then faded. STARSHIP STREAKER was through early.
