TATTENHAM raced close up from the outset, bid outside RICO SUAVE to gain the lead after six furlongs then drew off smartly while ridden out. FESSED UP made a middle move to contention after a half but was no match for the winner while saving the place. GALLICO unhurried early, closed a gap outside late. RICO SUAVE set a fast pace for six furlongs then gave way. SILVER DAY raced evenly. REVERE'S RIDE failed to menace. RAMMER chased early then came up empty. RUN ROBBY RUN was bumped after the break then stopped.
