Footnotes

PLEASANT TEMPER, allowed to settle early, waited patiently through the turn and into the stretch for clear racing room then split rivals in upper stretch and drew off smartly through the final furlong under a moderate hand ride. SANDY GATOR, void of early speed, fanned out six wide to get clear racing room turning for home then was best of the rest while no match for the winner. SCATTER BUY made a middle move, fanned four wide turning for home to launch a bid a furlong out but failed to sustain that rally late. MARVELLOUS SILVER also moved after five furlongs, angled out five wide to bid through mid stretch and also weakened in the late stages. PARIENTE BARBARA dueled for six furlongs, entered the stretch with a clear lead but had little left when the real test came. EAGER EATER, steadied along while boxed early, angled out to challenge three wide through the second turn and into the stretch then gave way under pressure. INNOVATE failed to menace. MISSY DEAR made a middle move, fanned seven wide then came up empty. SECRET OF FINE stalked the pace to the second turn and faded. JUST PLAIN JANE dueled to the quarter pole and stopped. (The portable inner rail was sent at zero feet.)
