UNION BOWMAN made an inside middle move, got through along the rail to challenge into the stretch but was no match for the winner while second best. FRANK'S CASTLE chased early, bid after five furlongs then flattened out. ROYAL NEWMAN dueled early, gained a clear lead in the second turn then gave way. ROAR OF THE SURGE was well placed early then weakened. UNO AGAIN showed little. DOWNINFRONT was no factor. KATHY'S MAN was no threat. FOUR F'S AND A D stopped. MY TOUGH TIGER was through early. MILE WAS HAND TIMED
