SHE'S A JET chased the early leader from the outset, bid out of the turn to vie for the lead then after dueling with that one through the stretch, edged clear late under pressure. LOOKS LIKE A GEM sprinted clear early, held on well when engaged by the winner out of the turn then dueled with that one til late before hanging while saving the place. PLEASE DON'T SHOOT made a four wide middle move then was slowly gaining late. ALYDEAR was well placed but had no rally. NATURE COAST weakened gradually. SHYANN LIBBY was well placed to the stretch then faded. VULPINE checked over heels early. LUCK IS BEST broke slow. WHAT ABOUT NOW showed little. ECHO'S RETURN bolted in the turn.
