ADMIRAL LANCE made an inside middle move to contention, angled out four wide out of the second turn to challenge for and gain a clear lead then lasted late over ASKFORARAISE under brisk handling. ASKFORARAISE was void of early speed, also advanced inside after five furlongs then swung five wide out of the second turn and finished well outside the winner but couldn't get up. NORTH BROAD was pushed out into HATTON CROSS when AWESOME OF COURSE bore out entering the backstretch, altered course inside that one to vie for the lead with RESURRECT to mid stretch then weakened. RESURRECT inherited the lead inside when AWESOME OF COURSE bore out, contested that lead inside to mid stretch then also weakened. AWESOME OF COURSE broke sharp to gain the early lead then bore out badly into NORTH BROAD into the stretch, was straightened to press the pace three wide then faded. HATTON CROSS was carried out badly into the backstretch then stopped. Following a stewards inquiry, AWESOME OF COURSE was disqualified from fifth and placed sixth. The portable inner rail was set at zero feet.
