ON TOUR made a middle move, bid five wide into the stretch then dueled to late and shared the win. MISFIT MANNY fanned six wide out of the turn, also dueled late and deadheaded. GENUINE HEART dueled to the furlong marker then weakened. JEWEL HEIST was well placed to mid stretch then gave way. GOLDZAR dueled inside then faded. CAN'T BUY LOVE raced evenly. EL MEXICANO was through early. DAYTONA BOUND showed little. RUN TO THE MAX was no factor.
