**Footnotes**

GRANDSTAND mid pack and between rivals, moved up and gained position four wide through the second turn, bid three wide into the stretch, then made a steady gain, drew off inside the furlong marker while being kept to the task. LILA WASHTA stalked the early pace three wide, gained a striking position through the second turn, bid between rivals into the stretch gaining a short lead, then could not match strides with the winner late, while clearly best of the rest. HOW COOL IS HE set the pace on the inside, stayed on when challenged into the stretch and weakened the final furlong. FOR THE AGES allowed to settle, looped rivals three wide through the second turn, came four wide to bid and got up for a share. SPINTASTIC mid pack and between rivals, moved up through the second turn, came three wide to bid and evened out. NITROGEN showed little. PLAUSIBLY was no factor. PEACEFUL PRINCE vied for the early lead outside and stopped. CAMELLIA GRILL was never involved. GREAT WHITE well placed and outside, drifted out and was through after a half.
