Footnotes

JACKFROST OFCOURSE tracked the early pace inside, angled out to move up through the turn and bid three wide into the stretch, then made a steady gain and drew off late under steady pressure. I SEE A SHARK allowed to settle, moved up through the turn on the two path, angled out in the stretch for clear racing room and closed well for the place position. EL MARTILLO well back, moved up three wide through the turn, bid on that path into the stretch and passed tiring rivals for the show. PUT TO THE TEST well placed and outside, moved to position four wide through the turn, bid on that path into the stretch and flattened out. STAR DISTINCTION stalked the pace on the outside, bid between rivals into the stretch and weakened in the drive. TOCCET MAN set the pace on the inside, stayed on when challenged through the turn, then faded the final furlong. BANYAN showed little, inside. WILD BLING was never involved.
