DANCE TO THE ROAR raced off the pace, saved ground, waited for room passing the quarter pole, split rivals, rallied inside and prevailed. PREOCCUPIED raced off the pace, made a four wide run on the turn, drifted out in upper stretch and dug in to the finish. DIRECTION TO PAY was bumped at the start, raced off the pace, came five wide into the lane and rallied mildly. BLUE HIGHWAY saved ground and failed to threaten. CAUSE I SAID was bumped at the start, raced inside, between foes on the far turn and failed to respond. PEPPERMINT PRINCE dueled inside and faded. CREDIT VOUCHER raced off the rail and failed to respond. IMAGE EXPRESS pulled early, dueled outside and gave way.
