ROCK LOBSTER made a middle move through the second turn, fanned five wide into the stretch then rallied past the leaders to be along in time while ridden out. TIGANELLO (GER) stalked the pace inside, got through along the rail into the stretch to challenge for and gain a short lead then hung late while saving the place. BEIJING HOUSE split rivals in the drive then made up some ground but too late. CONSTITUTION RIVER dueled to mid stretch then weakened. CONRAD CROSSING was well placed but had no rally. GO TO THE SUN was wide through the second turn then faded. DEAD RED was used up pressing the pace. DULANSKY was buried inside through the second turn. SHEIKH stopped.
