WINTHROP HOUSE made a middle move through the turn, angled out four wide into the stretch then rallied late to run down the leader in time. BROAD'S BEWARE dueled from the outset, shook clear leaving the furlong marker then hung late. ATLANTIC VENTURE was never far back then bid inside and was making up ground late. SAMMYTHEREDROCKER was well placed but lacked a strong late response. PEACEFUL SLEWTION closed a gap too late. FLY SO FAST was fractious at the gate then dueled early before weakening. E. J. LITTLE BOY failed to menace. MR RICHMOND SIR dueled to mid stretch before weakening. SARATOGA STORM was through early. TERREMOTICO showed little.
