VELVET DRIVE advanced steadily from the inside after a half, angled out for the drive then wore down BERCHTA in the late stages under brisk handling. The latter dueled early, drew off leaving the second turn then just failed to last late while clearly second best. ROSE A DAY made a mild move to contention then failed to sustain that rally. ADVANTAGE PLUS also gained inside to the stretch then had weakened under pressure. J' ALDAWNZA pressed the issue for six furlongs and faded. LATOURELL LIL passed tiring rivals. TWIST MY HEART was rated along early but never reached serious contention. BUCKSWITHSPANGLES was through after a half. MISSLEXUS showed little. LIBERTY LIGHT stopped. (The portable inner rail was set at zero feet.)
