D. J.'S SLEW chased the early leaders, bid four wide through the turn and into the stretch, drew clear in the furlong grounds then just lasted late. MERRY LIFT was off a step slow, advanced steadily behind and inside rivals, split horses in the furlong grounds then was steadily getting to the winner late in a good effort. COASTAL WOLF made a four wide middle move, bid through mid stretch then weakened late. RARE OVERTURE dueled inside for more than a half then gradually weakened. STRIKING T passed tiring rivals. MIKAY AS LADY also passed faders. HALLIE LAREDO raced close up for a half then gave way. K G LADY wouldn't load then was no factor. SOCIETY ZONE was hard used disputing the pace for a half then steadied in traffic while tiring. HOLE PONCHE stopped.
