RIGHT FLANKER stalked the early leaders for a half, bid four wide into the stretch to challenge for the lead then was all out to outfinish SEE SAW PLAYS after a stiff drive. SEE SAW PLAYS was roughed and squeezed at the break, recovered to advance inside after a half, split rivals into the stretch to challenge for the lead then after gaining a short advantage inside the final furlong, just missed. BELICHICK was slow to settle then was making up a bit of ground late behind the top two. SHAKESPEREAN STORY came out at the break to rough up and squeeze SEE SAWS PLAY, dueled to mid stretch then weakned. TOUGHER 'N MOST failed to menace. SOL ECLIPSE was through after a half. SHIPWATCH stopped. NOW BATTING came in at the break then was outdistanced.
