MILLENNIUMILLIONS made a middle move, angled inside then ran down the leader late. GOLD BUCK chased the early leader, bid outside that one into the upper stretch, showed strong stamina to carry a clear led into the late stages then just hung late. LORD CHAMPAGNE fanned five wide then was gaining along the outside late. FLORIDA'S QUIXOTE made a middle move to be in striking distance a furlong out but was outkicked. BUTEO led to upper stretch then slowly weakened. CACTUS GLACKEN failed to menace. CALLIGRAPHIST showed little. BOURBON LANE was no factor. SIR PERFECTION stopped.
