VINQTIEME rated kindly on the rail, got through in the second turn, to gain a short lead when asked, then drew clear late under steady handling. DIXIE CAUSEWAY allowed to settle well back, fanned five wide to gain clear racing room for the drive, then made a steady gain to get up for the place while no threat to the winner. STRIKING POWER hopped slightly at the start, stalked the early pace outside, then lacked the needed late response. B FOR BEEZ four wide through the first turn, looped rivals five wide through the second turn, then had no stretch rally. V I MONGOOSE broke in a the start, was checked and steadied repeatedly, raced boxed to the quarter pole, got through inside of rivals, then gave way. CODE NAME NOAH set the early pace just off the rail, faded after a half. LIDO KEY broke a step slowly, then was a brief factor outside.
