LAVA LAKE set a sold pace, drew off in the turn then continued well to late before just failing to last. FRISKY KRISSEY angled out six wide then made up some ground late outside. GENUINE FORGERY chased into the stretch then weakened. MARBELLA'S SLEW failed to menace. MISS K. O. was through after a half. TOUGH ARGUMENT had a wide trip. CAN YOU MAMBO was no factor. FEELING OPTIMISTIC showed little. DAN'S KY BLUE stopped.
