SANGAM, unhurried early, was blocked briefly into the second turn, split rivals passing the quarter pole to challenge the leader turning for home then drew off smartly through the final furlong. SCHMOOPY was slightly green and hard to rate setting the pace, resisted the winner to mid stretch then weakened but was able to save the place over DYNA MIGHT. The latter looped rivals through the second turn, fanned six wide for the drive and made up some ground late. WESTERN MELODY made a middle move but failed to sustain that rally. MISS MOMBO QUEEN was through after a half. ALL THE ANSWERS was slightly rank in traffic early, made a move through the second turn then came up empty. BELLA GATTO was eased back off the pace early, bid inside after six furlongs but also came up empty for the drive. MISS SANDY DEE was well wide through the opening five furlongs. DANCER'S TRUOLAUGH stopped. (The temporary inner rail was set at zero feet.)
