Footnotes

FAMILY FACTS rushed up to head the early pace setter through the turn three wide, then dueled with JR'S EXCHANGE through the stretch, drew clear in the late going under steady handling. RUNNING TEMPO slightly fractious in the gate, hopped slightly at the start, remained well back and drifted in slightly through the turn, then angled out in the stretch for clear racing room and closed fast to be clearly best of the rest. JR'S EXCHANGE vied for the early lead from the outside, came in slightly into the turn to brush PURLEY PRECIOUS, then dueled with the winner through the stretch and weakened in the late going while hold the show safe. PURELY PRECIOUS vied for the early lead from the inside, was brushed and forced to steady into the turn, then weakened in the final furlong. MISSION GAP fractious in the gate, swerved in leaving the chute, then angled four wide through the turn and ran evenly late. CHELSEA'S PRIME showed little. BOSTON WEST END chased the early pace outside, faded.
