LAREDO LIL vied for the lead three wide for six furlongs, drew off smartly when called upon out of the second turn and was clearly best. SHE DID IT HER WAY was blocked through the second turn, split horses into the stretch then outfinished the rest while no match for the winner. PAM'S GIRL fanned seven wide then lodged a mild rally while lugging in. SARA'S YANKEE GIRL was well placed to the stretch but had no rally. EXCLUSIVE HOPPER chased to mid stretch then gave way. AMBER NOTE passed tiring rivals. CLEVER MISS TRIXIE vied for the lead for five furlongs then faded. SANGUE'S CROWN showed little. NANCY'S SPIRIT made a middle move to the stretch then faltered. PIXEL was used up. The portable inner rail was set at 12 feet.
