ABRASIVE STONE was well placed from the outset, bid three wide out of the second turn then after dueling to late, drew clear under pressure. SWING THE CAT (NZ) eased back off the lead after breaking alertly, bid after seven furlongs, dueled to late then hung while second best. MAXAMAX was in striking distance out of the second turn but failed to gain in the drive. JET PASS rushed to the lead into the first turn, set the pace to upper stretch then faltered. INDY'S TREASURE was well placed but had no rally. WILDCAT LEGACY rushed to contention after six furlongs then came up empty. SEA WALKER was rank inside then showed little. PUN INTENDED was through after a half. RUBY FALLS showed little. CHUNDOO stopped. The portable inner rail was set at 12 feet.
