SUR SANDPIT showed strong speed to vie for the early lead, moved clear on the backstretch then showed strong stamina to shake off a bid from BANKERS HIGH YIELD leaving the second turn to mid stretch before shaking clear late. BANKERS HIGH YIELD stalked the pace early, bid three wide after five furlongs then hung late while saving the place. BRIDLED QUEST raced wide much of the way and failed to gain late. FIRE STRIKER chased the leader early, bid after five furlongs then weakened. PAWNSAY looped five wide through the second turn then also came up empty. PSYCHIC STAR showed little. CLASSIC MOON stopped. NORTHERN ACADEMY was no factor.
