SUNSATONAL made a three wide middle move, challenged leaving the second turn, held on well when the winner shook clear then came on again late. DIAMOND STEAL set a solid pace then faded. DANCER'S LEGACY raced evenly. WILD TURK stalked the pace inside but had no rally. KING MONGO failed to menace. BLAZING PRIZE was well placed for six furlongs then gave way. GONNA BLOW showed little. BELLO PAPP stopped.
