**Footnotes**

FORESTRY TYPE set the early pace well off the rail, edged clear through the turn, then drew off through the stretch under brisk left hand urging. BLACK BELT vied for the early lead outside early, then couldn't go with the winner through the turn but stayed on to be clearly second best. HOUNGUN in the second flight and four wide, moved up through the turn, then could not gain through the stretch run. TAXES FOR BEN stalked the early pace outside, drifted in slightly through the turn while gaining ground, then flattened out in the stretch run. KARA'S ORIENTATION fractious in the gate, was in the second flight and between rivals, then was bumped by SWITCHING TO GLIDE and faded. TEETEE'S TAPIT showed little. SWITCHING TO GLIDE well placed in the early going, angled out to bump KARA'S ORIENTATION, drifted to the rail and faltered.
