PEMBROK PINES stalked the early pace, made a four wide middle move to contention then after dueling with NANCY BAYBEE through the furlong grounds, drew off late. NANCY BAYBEE dueled inside, gained a clear lead leaving the turn then resisted the winner to the final sixteenth before weakening while saving the place. NATIVE WAGER made a wide middle move then was slowly gaining late. MAYIMBE dueled inside to the quarter pole then weakened. PIRATE'S WAGER passed tiring rivals. ERIN OF WICKLOW chased to the stretch then gave way. OH SHOOT also chased the leaders for five furlongs then faded. KAY BEE GEE showed little. P J'S KID was no factor and was outdistanced.
