TAX DAY SLEW raced close up, got through inside into the turn then dueled through a long drive while showing strong stamina before narrowly prevailing. I LOVE TO SAY YES pressed the pace three wide from the outset, also continued gamely through a long drive and just missed late. MONTALCINO pressed the pace four wide much of the way but was outkicked late. SOARING STORM made a middle move to mid stretch but lacked a strong late response. CASUAL FRIDAY dueled early, came in into the turn then weakened in the final furlong. NINA'S GIFT vied for the early lead then was shuffled back into the turn. BEHAVE was through after a half. MECKE'S MOMENT failed to menace. MISS RUSTER showed little. PAMPERED LADY stopped. A claim of foul by the trainer of I LOVE TO SAY YES against the winner for interference in the stretch was disallowed.
