FRONTIER FRANNY set a slow pace into the stretch, couldn't turn back the winner late but bested the rest. THE LADY WAFFLES was well placed but failed to respond in the drive. KERI'S ANGEL lodged a mild rally inside. LYDIA'S LOVE looped four wide through the second turn then flattened out. TARVA was well placed to the stretch then gave way. SILVERDOLLARDELLA showed little.
