TOUR HOSTESS was eased back and angled to the inside leaving the chute to stalk the pace along the rail, slipped through passing the quarter pole to challenge for the lead, drew clear leaving the furlong marker then was all out to turn back COLUMBIAN CAT late. COLUMBIAN CAT raced close up early, held on well when the winner drew clear inside the final furlong then finished well late and was best of the rest. ARROGANT CAT made a four wide middle move then was slowly gaining late. TOO SASSY FOR U also made a middle move to pose a threat a furlong out then was outfinished late. WINGS OF POWER stalked the pace for more than five furlongs but had no rally. BARBS KIPPER passed tiring rivals. TWISTINGANDTURNING was through after a half. TILLTHELASTDOGDIES dueled to mid stretch then faltered. LAST AXE showed little.
