### Footnotes

FIRST TO KNOW was well placed inside for six furlongs, found room between rivals in upper stretch to challenge for and gain the lead then prevailed late under pressure. BEIJING HOUSE made a middle move through the second turn, had to wait for racing room into the furlong grounds then followed the winner through the hole in the drive and finished willingly late. FLATTER THIS was void of speed to the stretch then made up some ground late. STOLEN CHEVY dueled inside to mid stretch then weakened. MARBLE CLIFF raced evenly. BANDIT PRINCE vied for the lead three wide to mid stretch then gave way. TRI POWER dueled to mid stretch then also gave way.
