BRIEFLY chased the early leader, bid out of the turn, drew clear leaving the furlong grounds then was strongly handled to prevail late over REALLY STRIKING. REALLY STRIKING was hung four wide much of the way then was slowly gaining on the winner late. SHE'S A JET stalked the leaders three wide but lacked a strong late response. RON'S GAL dueled to mid stretch then gave way. IRISH CODE chased inside to the stretch but had no rally. VINTAGE PUNCH passed tiring rivals. BOB THE QUICK raced evenly. HI TIME'S LISA failed to menace. PREMIERESS showed little. RIGHT TO APPEAL stopped badly after a half.
