MARQUETTA stalked the pace inside to upper stretch, swung out four wide for clear racing room then ran down DANKEE'S HANKY in the final strides. DANKEE'S HANKY sprinted clear early, repulsed a bid from MYSTERIOUSNESS through the furlong grounds to regain a clear lead then just failed to last. VICTORIA'S AFFAIR was roughed up badly at the break to be last early, settled after five furlongs then closed with a rush outside but too late. MYSTERIOUSNESS chased the leader from the outset, bid out of the turn to be a threat past mid stretch then faltered late. BOHICA chased inside to mid stretch then weakened. DEB PIXUM raced evenly. TRY A THING showed little. DAWN'S NOT QUIET was no factor. SUNDAY'S PLEASURE bore out badly at the break to rough up VICTORIA'S AFFAIR then was through early.
