BAD BAD GIRL broke through the starting gate prior to the start, stalked the pace outside but failed to gain in the drive. NO SWEETHEART was well placed inside but had no response. JUST JEANNIE chased the early leader, drew clear after three furlongs but weakened in the final furlong. SO FONG failed to threaten. MORE CHARM passed faders. ON THE FRINGE showed little. APRIL COLORS was no factor. CHERIS' NOVELTY stopped. SPECTULAR PATT was through early. JOLIE BEAN rushed to the lead early then came up empty.
