GADOLINIUM advanced steadily after a half then ran down the leader from the outside late. SILVER RUSH vied for the early lead, shook free into the turn, drew off to mid stretch then just failed to last. ITCHY TOES fanned eight wide out of the turn then lodged a mild rally. UDENIABLE QUEEN was well placed much of the way but failed to gain. BOOK THE BULLET raced evenly. ALIE'S DOLLY made a middle move to the stretch then came up empty. TWO CONDOS passed tiring rivals. RUN FOR SAM vied early, remained close up for five furlongs then bobbled into the stretch and was not pressed thereafter. COHIBA'S WILDCHILD was no factor. PERFECT CONNECTION showed little. HOP ON IT was outdistanced.
