WARACHA was never far back, fanned six wide into the stretch for clear racing room then rallied past the leaders along the outside and won going away while ridden out. SILVER EAGLE was hard to load, looped five wide into the stretch then after driving to a clear lead, weakened late while saving the place. THERE GOES TRIPPI steadied along in traffic through the second turn then lodged a mild bid inside late. WILD WEEKEND bid four wide into the stretch, drifted out in upper stretch then weakened. TOO LOW passed tiring rivals. BLACK DIAMOND DAN bid three wide after five furlongs then was in tight into the stretch. JUDE'S STAR vied for the lead for five furlongs then faded. WITHLOTSOFCOURAGE stalked the leaders early, bid three wide in the second turn to gain a short lead but gave way in the drive. PEAVEY set a slow pace then faded. POKEYS PUNCH was pulled up. A claim of foul by the rider of BLACK DIAMOND DAN against WILD WEEKEND and SILVER EAGLE for interference into the stretch was disallowed.
