RUNNIN DA FENCES was bumped early by SARINDI, bid four wide leaving the turn then pulled away through the final furlong under pressure. SHARKIOWA chased early, got through inside in the turn to challenge for and gain a short lead but was no match for the winner late while second best. WOODRUFF RIDGE set a moderate pace early then slowly gave way. COVER PRICE passed tiring rivals. SARINDI came out to bump the winner early, bid three wide in the turn then also weakened in the final furlong. LIL SKELETOL raced evenly. MAKAAAN was no factor.
