Footnotes

PICK FOUR raced close up from the outset, bid outside the leader into the stretch then dueled to late before shaking clear. LIVE IN JOY vied for the early lead, shook clear on the backstretch, resisted the winner when challenged to late before hanging but bested the rest. COMMON SENSE was void of early speed, split rivals advancing after six furlongs then made up some ground late. SLICK VIC closed a late gap. DR. SKIP made an inside middle move then flattened out. ARONEY was well placed early then gave way. ASHTYN TOO vied early then came up empty. GREAT AZTEC chased for six furlongs then faded. CANO CODE showed little. PICAROO stopped.
