SNIFFLES stalked inside for five furlongs, angled off the rail out of the second turn to go after the leaders then proved narrowly best after a stiff drive. WILLA CATHER made an inside middle move, got through along the rail in the furlong grounds to loom a threat but was outfinished late. TUNE UP THE BAND chased from the outset, bid outside the leader out of the second turn to also loom a threat but was also outfinished late. POISE set a fast pace to near mid stretch then gave way. HUNTINGHETRUTH failed to menace. PAR GOLFER was well placed and had no excuse. SONG OF NORA showed little. The portable inner rail was set at zero feet.
