**Footnotes**

BRIDLED QUEST raced close up inside, got through to press the issue after a half then shook off ALARMING AFLEET leaving the furlong marker and slowly pulled away late. ALARMING AFLEET set a solid pace, resisted the winner to the final furlong then weakened while saving the place. SOY LATINO also raced close up, bid three wide into the stretch then also weakened late. FIRE STRIKER passed tiring rivals inside. D'S DESSERT was well placed to the stretch then gave way. OSTIN'S MIRACLE also passed faders. PETESAMASSBRED failed to menace. SHOCK N STORM was through after a half. CAN B VALID showed little. BANKERS HIGH YIELD stopped.
